What is Liberland?

On 13 April 2015 Vít Jedlička founded a new state called Liberland which is situated on what had been no-man's-land (terra nullius) between Croatia and Serbia on the River Danube.

Liberland is a free republic with the world's most free constitution, guaranteeing individual rights in a way, never seen before, and entirely built on libertarian principles. With the motto of "Live and let live", Liberland strives to become a voluntarist and free market jurisdiction, focusing on providing personal and economic freedom for all its citizens.



Unfortunately at present (May 2015), and even though Liberland is widely recognized by hundreds of thousands worldwide and attracting much sympathy (also from neighboring Serbia), Croatian authorities have taken it upon themselves to quell this new nation through unilateral border blockades and interventions on Liberland territory, which at best are dubious in regards to international law and the Danube convention.

What is the 'Liberland Settlement Association' (LSA)?



The LSA is a volunteer, non-profit association, formed in Switzerland but enlisting members internationally.

The LSA is an idealistically founded association, dedicated to the practical work of establishing a free and sovereign Liberland free state and establishing a permanent settlement within it. Out settler-activists are what will make Liberland happen!

While the LSA is driven mainly by volunteer work, its projects and operations are sponsored by various organizations through donations, with the current main sponsor being a Liberlandian company, the Liberland Settlement Corporation (LSC).

Thus, dedicated volunteers can expect full support in the form of lodging, food & drink - and tools and support with which to accomplish the mission, as well as working in the context of an overall plan to secure Liberland independence.

The LSA was created to support and coordinate and work as "boots on the ground" in the effort to ensure full Liberland independence, and to establish a permanent settlement in Liberland, in what is shaping up to be the greatest social experiment of the decade.

How do you get to the LSA base camp?



The base camp is currently located in Serbia, and you need to bring a valid passport, even if you are not crossing any borders.

The camp is located on the forested banks of the Danube,

Later a part of the camp might be shifted to Liberland itself. But at present, we send over our activist teams from the safety of the base camp.

We will assist with arrangements for your travel to our camp. We have LSA cars which can pick up settlers and activists from nearby towns and airports.

The LSA main camp is by now growing fast. We have power through generators, WIFI internet, a nice although rudimentary bar, two large community tents, our own powerful river boat, a Landrover made available for the camp – and nearby “real” beds and showers for occasional use.

The LSA camp is growing by the minute, and the camp and the organization itself will give settlers and activists the perfect staging point to make Liberland happen!



Generally, the LSA is all about providing the proper framework for making Liberland happen. The LSA base camp is the staging point and community center for this effort. Things do however progress very rapidly, and information changes on a daily basis.

We hope to welcome you soon in the LSA base Camp – and that you will engage in the worth-while struggle to establish Liberland and build a society the way it should be!

What do you need if you want to come to the LSA base camp?



The base camp is currently located in Serbia, and you need to bring a valid passport. Also – please make sure you have health insurance coverage, for the duration of your stay.

Please contact us when you have made your travelling arrangements, so that we know you are coming, and so we can assist in pick-ups from airport etc.

You should be self-sufficient, so you should bring everything that you will need. While we will feed dedicated activists and settlers, tourists or those with special needs will have to fend for themselves.

There are possibilities to buy most anything in the nearby towns, but we advise you bring:


- A travelling backpack
- A reusable and durable water bottle
- Something that keeps you warm at night (e.g. a sleeping bag)
- Bring a tent if you have one.
- Personal medication and emergency pack
- Passport, and if available, driver's license and boating license
- Flashlight
- A mobile phone, and ask for assistance on-site to swap to Serbian/Croatian SIM cards.

Once you arrive at base camp, you will be expected to fill out a form to join the LSA. This is to protect you legally against lawsuits and to ensure we have the contact info of every member, including nationality and next-of-kin phone numbers, should you be detained by Croatian authorities through activism.

No one will be forced to put themselves directly at risk by challenging the Croatian authorities, but some of us must, as it is the only way to secure a free and sovereign Liberland.

We need personnel for all kinds of tasks on-site, and direct activism and crossing into Liberland to raise our flags and settle our land, is just one of them.

Those unable to camp in the wild, for medical reasons or otherwise, will receive assistance in finding local accommodations, priced as low as 10 EUR/night. While we expect those who need something out of the ordinary to support themselves, financial support may be given by the LSA for those truly dedicated to the cause.



What compensation and support can one expect?



We expect volunteers who are ideologically driven – to come and help with liberating and settling Liberland. If your attitude is “what’s in it for me” you are knocking on the wrong door.

If you are interested in settling in Liberland and getting citizenship, when all the hard work is done, and even everyone else paid the expenses – please go join the 250’000 long queue of other free-riders and hope for the best. It will be remembered who helped when it was needed, on-site through the LSA, or economically as a LSC shareholder, when Liberlandian citizenships and residence permits will be handed out.


That said, the LSA provides plenty of support!

We expect you to travel to nearby airports at your own expense. Or to drive to near the base camp yourselves.

Once there, if you have contacted us – the organization will take over and bring you to base camp.

We see three types of people arriving. Tourists, who want to stay for a weekend to get a part of the Liberland experience. Party-seekers who want to sit all day and drink beer, watching history unfold. And those dedicated to work within the LSA to see Liberland happen. The LSA provides its full support to the last mentioned.

- We’ll offer LSA-activists and settlers food and drink, and a space to camp in the base camp.
- We offer you access to the community tools, such as boats and cars.
- You have access to community power and WiFi.
- We provide some legal assistance if needed from the local Liberland lawyer – and we cover fines you get from activist duties.
- We offer beers and local brandy on irregular basis – it’s not all hard work ☺
- We’ll offer you a real bed once in a while, especially if the weather is bad or if you have been many days in the field.
- We offer you recreational stays on a nice hotel in nearby towns, if you are recuperating after time spend in the care of Croatian authorities.
- We offer you a chance to be part of history in the making.



The LSA is supported through donations from the investor company the LSC.

It is also the LSC which provides the expensive equipment which the LSA leases. The LSC holding claim to real estate in Liberland thus hopes to aid indirectly in accomplishing Liberland sovereignty.

Dedicated settlers and activists can also be expected to receive some monetary compensation as dictated by the onsite LSA camp management, in the area of CHF 75/Day, but under obligation to reinvest these funds in LSC-shares.

Thus you indirectly become a Liberland real estate owner. But please note that conditions of this monetary incentive may change as the project develops.

Last – all dedicated LSA members, as well as LSC investors can be guaranteed preferential treatment in regards to Liberland citizenship and/or greencards.
