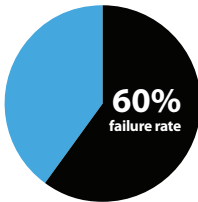
Paolo Cuomo is COO of Charles Taylor Managing Agency, which draws on Charles Taylor's depth of professional insurance services and global network to offer market-
