



UniCredit and the Open Bank Project launch the 2016 online Appathon: a global competition for financial technology developers and start-ups

Berlin, June 13th, 2016 – UniCredit, together with UniCredit Business Integrated Solutions and with the Open Bank Project, will launch the 2016 online Appathon.

UniCredit is a leading European financial group with an international network spanning 50 markets. With more than 7,800 branches^[1] and almost 143,000^[2] employees serving more than 30 million clients, the Group has commercial banking operations in 17 countries.

The 2016 Appathon is driven by the Open Bank Project API (Application Programming Interface), developed by the Berlin-based TESOBÉ Ltd/Open Bank Project. Simon Redfern, CEO of TESOBÉ Ltd/Open Bank Project, notes: “an API enables innovation to happen in faster and unexpected ways. Innovative developers and entrepreneurs can quickly imagine, design and code ‘out of the box’ solutions, using the rock-solid, secure services provided by the UniCredit bank. This allows the bank to more quickly understand and integrate innovations for the benefit of their customers. We are thrilled to be working with Unicredit, a banking group that is clearly serious about partnering with outside start-ups and innovators across the globe.”

Paolo Cederle, CEO of UniCredit Business Integrated Solutions, the global service company of the Group, says: “we want the Appathon to help us foster innovation and translate thoughts into new products and services that benefit our customers; by opening the API to participants, they can create functioning app prototypes that shorten the production process”.

The Appathon will be run in a controlled environment (‘sandbox’) using test data emulating real-life situations. In addition to the professional collaboration package worth €50,000 for the winning team, participants can win additional prizes and bonus gifts

Participants will face challenges on the themes of:

- PSD2
- Moment-Based Insight
- Digital Wallet 2.0

Participants can leverage these challenges to focus on current technology trends including biometrics, mobile wallets/payments, artificial intelligence, social media banking in conjunction with new and emerging business models.

Winning apps will be concrete ideas and proposals aligned with the business needs of the UniCredit Group. Successful entries will be suitable for immediate development and integration with UniCredit Business Integrated Solutions, the global service company of the Group.

Participants can apply online with an app connected to the Open Bank Project API. Ten teams will be selected to demo their applications in Milan on July 20 for UniCredit's senior management who will determine the winners of the competition.
